

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Marion City intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the state. The City will be eligible for \$105,000 of fiscal year 2013 CDBG funding, provided the City meets applicable program requirements. On February 11 2013 the City Council conducted their first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements. Based on both citizens input and local officials' assessments of the city's needs, Jobs and Economic Development Committee of Council is tentatively proposing to consider undertaking the following CDBG activities for fiscal year 2013:

Street Improvements (Holmes & Union St.)	41,000
Boys & Girls Club Playground paving	43,000
<u>Environmental Review/Audit/Admin/Fair Housing</u>	<u>21,000</u>
TOTAL	105,000

A second public hearing will be held on May 28, 2013 at 7:30 PM in the Council's Chambers, 2nd Floor of City Hall, 233 West Center St., to give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the City's proposed CDBG application to the Ohio Department of Development. Citizens are encouraged to attend to express their views and comments on the proposed application.
